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1. Introduction:

Future Wings Academy is a remedial school dedicated to providing quality education for learners with Specific Learning Disabilities. We are registered with the Department of Education as an LSEN - school. Our school was established in 2020 by a team of three therapists: Speech Language Therapist, an Audiologist, an Occupational Therapist, and an Educational Psychologist. With a strong focus on therapeutic principles, we aim to create an inclusive and supportive learning environment for our students.

2. Academic Approach:

At Future Wings Academy, we follow the CAPS curriculum. Our classes are kept small with a maximum of 12 learners per class. English and Afrikaans are the languages of instruction. The Foundation Phase classes are predominantly presented in parallel medium, while the Intermediate and FET phases follow a dual-medium model. Our dedicated team of therapists are available on the premises, although individual therapy sessions are not included in the school fees.

3. Therapeutic program:

- A therapeutic program compiled by the team of therapists will be followed at school regularly. It forms part of their daily routine. This includes fine and gross motor activities, a visual perception program, sensory stimulation, auditory processing activities, and Remedial intervention. (Grade 1 – 4)
- A self-regulation program is implemented in the classroom to assist with modulation and concentration difficulties.
- Our Gr. 1- 6 learners attend individual reading sessions once a week.



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4. The difference between Remedial schools and other Special Needs Schools:

Many parents find it difficult to understand the difference between the various schools in the South African schooling system, and therefore a short explanation is supplied:

- Put very simply, remedial education applies to children who have average to above average intellectual abilities, but do not perform according to their potential because of difficulties with reading and/or writing and/or arithmetic.
- Children with High functioning Autistic Spectrum Disorder, Dyslexia, Dysgraphia or Dyscalculia, ADD/ADHD, Communication Disorder, SPD, Auditory perception difficulties, and Hearing loss are catered for in a remedial school. We want to emphasise that we do not cater for children with behavioural difficulties. Remedial teaching and therapeutic input are provided to help learners reach their full potential and to bridge the gaps in learning.
- This furthermore implies that a child in a remedial school should be able to cope with the demands of a curriculum, such as CAPS. Children in a remedial school follow the normal schooling phases, and grades from Grade 1 to Grade 12.
- Whereas special educational facilities cater for children with below-average intellectual abilities. Children in these schools follow an adapted CAPS curriculum, and they do not complete a full Grade 12, with 7 subjects, but instead, they do an adapted programme with 5 Grade 12 subjects. Special Educational facilities cater for learners with Mild Intellectual Disabilities (MID) and Severe Intellectual Disabilities (SID).

5. Location and Ethos:

We are located at Krui Kerk/Church on Fiskaal Street, Glen Marais. Our school's ethos is based on Christian values, fostering a caring and respectful community.

6. Admission Process:

Prospective learners are expected to undergo screening by our multi-disciplinary team. Further assessments may be requested when necessary. Following the initial screening, students will be invited to attend a trial week at the school. Based on the results and the trial period, a decision will be made regarding the placement of the learner. (Please see the attached Admission policy.)



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7. School Uniform:

A navy blue branded shirt/golf shirt with navy school shorts and takkies is worn daily.
Two options for a warm school jacket are available.
A school tracksuit is available for winter, or the school jacket and shirt may be worn with jeans.
No torn jeans may be worn or fit too tightly.
All branded wear can be ordered from the office.
The wearing of the above-mentioned branded wear is compulsory.

8. School Hours:

- Grades R – 3: Monday to Thursday, 07h30-13h30
- Grade 4 and up: Monday to Thursday, 07h30-14h15
- All grades: Friday, 07h30-13h30

9. Aftercare Facilities:

We offer aftercare facilities at Future Wings Academy at an extra cost. If you plan on utilizing this service, kindly inform us, and we will provide you with additional forms to gather the relevant information.

10. Financial Structure:
